There are two ways to enter the museum.

You may come through the entrance on Whitehall (the main street). Head straight through the gates and into the archway.














The other way to enter the museum is across Horseguards Parade. Head towards the palace and you will see some signs for the museum.





Once you have followed the signs, you will see the museum's entrance which looks like this.



If you go through the door that is straight ahead, you can buy a ticket for the museum.

When you come inside, you will see two automatic doors.

If you go through the door on the right, you will come to the gift shop. You can also come back to the gift shop after the museum.






When you get to the ticket desk, there will be someone there to sell you tickets. You can ask for an audioguide at the ticket desk too.


If you look down at the floor, you will notice the cobbled floor. Be careful when you walk because it's bumpy!






If you come in through the door on the right, you will come into the gift shop! If you don't want to visit the gift shop right away, you will pass by it on the way out too.





To get to the toilet, go up the ramp in the gift shop and you will see a door to the disabled toilet on your left. We only have one toilet in the museum.



To open the door, press this button which says 'PUSH TO OPEN'. Or you can push the door and it will open automatically.



When you have bought your tickets and are ready to enter the museum, walk past the barriers and you will see the first gallery!



The stables are in the next gallery.






You can look through a window to see the military stables used by the cavalry (and you may see a few horses!)

You will also see some uniforms hanging up. You can try these on and take some pictures.



There are benches to sit on at the back of the stables if you are feeling tired.



If you go into the stalls, you will see some touch screens where you can press the buttons to learn more about the cavalry.






After you have seen the stables, you will enter the last gallery. This gallery is a little bit bigger and has lots of objects about the history of the cavalry.



Once you reach the end of the last gallery you will see some more videos about the cavalry and a bench to sit on.



You will also see another touchscreen that you can use to learn more about the cavalry.



After you have finished going around the museum, you will come back to the gift shop. You can have a look and see if you want to buy something or you can go back outside.
